

Jesus Came for Us: A Christmas Attitude

The Christmas Season is a special time of the year as we celebrate the birth of Jesus. However, the Christmas Season can be a stressful time of the year, and we can easily lose sight of the reason we celebrate Christmas. Our focus in ABIDE for the month of December is on the Gospel message: Jesus came for us. Jesus came to rescue us and give us eternal life and a new life in Christ.

Let's begin by reading Philippians 2:4-11 and asking the Spirit to speak to our hearts today.

“Everyone should look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. Adopt the same attitude as that of Christ Jesus, who, existing in the form of God, did not consider equality with God as something to be exploited. Instead he emptied himself by assuming the form of a servant, taking on the likeness of humanity. And when he had come as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death – even to death on a cross. For this reason God highly exalted him and gave him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee will bow – in heaven and on earth and under the earth – and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father” (Philippians 2:4-11).
