Prayers of Invitation

Luke 2:1-20 tells the story of the birth of Jesus. Luke 2:7 says, "Then she gave birth to her firstborn Son, and she wrapped him tightly in cloth and laid him in a manger, because there was no guest room available for them."

Jesus came to earth and was born in a manger. A humble manger that was dirty and had no beauty and glory until He entered.
